Signatures In-Lieu of filing fee can be counted toward the number of signatures required for the candidate's nomination papers. If the candidate's Signatures In-Lieu of filing fee petition contains the requisite number of valid signatures required for their nomination papers, the county elections office shall not require the candidate to circulate nomination papers.  A candidate may prepare a candidate statement on the appropriate form provided by the elections official. The statement may include the name, age, and occupation of the candidate, and a brief description of the candidate's education and qualifications expressed by the candidate. The statement shall be filed in the election's office at the time the candidate's nomination papers are returned/filed.
