NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN BY COURTNEY BAILEY-KANELOS REGISTRAR OF VOTERS FOR SACRAMENTO COUNTY IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THE ELECTIONS LAWS OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA THAT ON TUESDAY, JUNE 7, 2022, THERE WILL BE A STATEWIDE DIRECT PRIMARY ELECTION.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN THAT AT THE STATEWIDE DIRECT PRIMARY ELECTION THE FOLLOWING MEASURE SHALL BE PUT TO A VOTE FOR THE QUALIFIED VOTERS IN THE COUNTY OF SACRAMENTO.

Measure C:
Shall the Sacramento County Vehicle Abatement Program and associated vehicle registration and renewal fees (\$1.00 dollar per vehicle and an additional \$2.00 dollars for certain commercial vehicles) be extended for a ten-year term under California Vehicle Code Sections 9250.7 and 22710, or any successor statutes thereto, for the purposes of removal and disposal of abandoned, wrecked, dismantled, or inoperative vehicles?

RESOLUTION NO. 2022-0131
A RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF SACRAMENTO (1) APPROVING THE EXTENSION OF THE SACRAMENTO ABANDONED VEHICLE SERVICE AUTHORITY (SAVSA) VEHICLE REGISTRATION PROGRAM FEE, AND (2) REQUESTING CONSOLIDATION OF ELECTION AND ORDERING OF SUCH ELECTION, AND (3) AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2021-22 BUDGET, ALLOCATING \$50,007 TO THE SAVSA TO DEFRAY COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH PLACING THE MEASURE ON THE BALLOT

WHEREAS, the Sacramento Abandoned Vehicle Service Authority (SAVSA) was created in 1992, and its members include jurisdictions in Sacramento County performing abandoned vehicle abatement, and is overseen by the Sacramento Transportation Authority (STA); and

WHEREAS, SAVSA oversees a financing mechanism resulting in the collection of one (\$1.00) dollar on each Sacramento County vehicle registration and an additional two (\$2.00) dollars for certain commercial vehicles through the California Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) and provides reimbursement for abandoned vehicle abatement costs to participating agencies ("the SAVSA Fee"); and

WHEREAS, the County of Sacramento joined SAVSA in 1992 and currently receives approximately \$350,000.00 annually for the reimbursement of abandoned vehicle abatement costs; and

WHEREAS, the SAVSA Fee sunsets every ten (10) years, with the program set to expire on April 30, 2022; and

WHEREAS, extension of the SAVSA Fee requires the approval of 2/3 of the County Board of Supervisors and "a majority of the cities having a majority of the incorporated population within the county." (Cal. Vehicle Code, § 9250.7(g)); and

WHEREAS, it has been determined by SAVSA that pursuant to California Proposition 26 the program cannot be renewed without a two-thirds majority approval by the County electorate, with Sacramento County's share of the election costs being \$50,007; and

WHEREAS, the County of Sacramento desires to support the extension of the SAVSA Fee and order the placement of the proposed Abandoned Vehicle Abatement (AVA) Tax Measure included in the Attachment hereto and incorporated by reference herein on the June 2022 ballot authorizing the collection of the program fees on Sacramento County vehicle registrations, and in turn continue the SAVSA program providing reimbursement of abandoned vehicle abatement costs to participating agencies.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that two-thirds of the Board of Supervisors for the County of Sacramento:

(1) Approves the extension of the SAVSA Fee pursuant to Vehicle Code Section 9250.7(g); and

(2) Orders the placement of the proposed Abandoned Vehicle Abatement Tax Measure text, as stated in the Attachment hereto and incorporated herein by reference, on the June, 2022 ballot to renew the Sacramento Abandoned Vehicle Service Authority (SAVSA) Vehicle Registration Program; and

(3) Hereby approves an amendment to the Fiscal Year 2021-2022 Budget for the allocation of \$50,007 to SAVSA to defray a portion of costs associated with placing the above-referenced tax measure on the 2022 ballot; specifically, the approval of this amendment increases expenditure appropriations in the Code Enforcement 5725729 budget unit within the General Fund by \$50,007.

On a motion by Supervisor Desmond, seconded by Supervisor Kennedy, the foregoing Resolution was passed and adopted by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Sacramento this 15th day of February, 2022, by the following vote, to wit:

March 18, through Sunday, March 27, 2022.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that California Elections Code Section 9600 governs the form of said arguments and/or rebuttals. Arguments and/or rebuttals submitted to the Sacramento County Elections Office must follow E.C. 9600. Authors of said arguments/rebuttals may call the Elections Office (916) 875-6276 for more information on submitting an argument for or against a measure. To be eligible for printing and distribution as provided by law, such arguments and rebuttals must be received and filed at Voter Registration and Elections, 7000 65th Street, Suite A, Sacramento CA 95823, no later than said date and time. All arguments and rebuttals must be submitted in block format. Limited use of bolding, underlining, capitalizing, italics or bullets (small solid circle only) is permitted. Arguments and rebuttals that are not in compliance will be reformatted and set in uniform type.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that Vote by Mail processing may begin on the 29th day before the election, which is Monday, May 9, 2022. All ballots cast in the June 7, 2022 Statewide Direct Primary Election shall be tallied at the central counting place, the Voter Registration and Elections Office at 7000 65th Street, Suite A, Sacramento, California. Initial results will be available at 8:00 p.m. on election night and continue until the count is completed.
