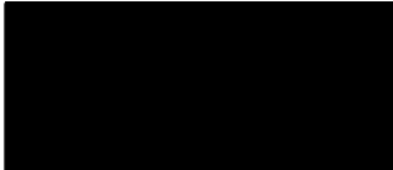

**NOTICE OF INTENTION TO CIRCULATE RECALL PETITION TO THE HONORABLE Saul Hernandez:**  
Pursuant to Section 11020, California Elections Code, the undersigned registered qualified voters of the San Juan Unified School District, of the County of Sacramento in the State of California, hereby give notice that we are the proponents of a recall petition and that we intend to seek your recall and removal from the office of Board Member, in the San Juan Unified School District School Board, Sacramento, California, and to demand election of a successor in that office.

The grounds for the recall are as follows: Parents and Citizens of Sacramento seek to recall Saul Hernandez, Board Member San Juan Unified School District. Hernandez is failing to represent his constituents. He is denying and rationing students access to schools, staff, and services. His actions are having undeniably profound, and negative consequences on students, of which he is fully aware. Although the health department and the Governor issued guidance and executive orders concerning education, Hernandez is undoubtedly using his local authority to reduce the district's liability and keep students out of the classrooms. He continues to survey parents/staff, who have responded with a majority vote to return to school; and continues to vote against the return to in-person learning even when it was safe to do so. Much of the "guidance" Hernandez is using appears to conflict with or has superseded long standing laws and education codes. Actions of Hernandez have clearly reduced the instructional minute students receive. Parents can no longer condone these reckless and ill-advised actions of Hernandez. He was elected and sworn to uphold laws; not outside "guidance" he has allegedly received that facilitates disparities, widens achievement gaps, and harms students in ways he has failed to either calculate, consider, or resolve.
