## Do you want to vote for a presidential candidate in the March 2024 Election?

You received this postcard because you are not registered with a political party and are considered a No Party Preference voter. Some parties will allow you to crossover and vote for their candidates. As a No Party Preference voter, you have three options:

- 1. Do nothing. You will be mailed a ballot in early February that **does not** include candidates for President.
- 2. Complete the request on the other side of this postcard to crossover and vote for an American Independent Party, Democratic Party or Libertarian Party Presidential candidate, and return it by **January 7, 2024** to ensure your preferred ballot is mailed to you in early February.
- 3. Re-register with the Green Party, Peace & Freedom Party or Republican Party by **February 19, 2024** to be mailed a ballot with that party's Presidential candidates. You can register to vote online at <a href="https://www.registertovote.ca.gov">www.registertovote.ca.gov</a>.
