

NOTICE OF ELECTION

Notice is hereby given that Sacramento County Employees' Retirement System will conduct a Member Election during the period of September 15 through September 26, 2025, for the purpose of electing to the Board of Retirement:

ALTERNATE RETIREE REPRESENTATIVE

The term of office begins January 1, 2026, and ends December 31, 2028.

ELIGIBILITY: To be eligible to be a candidate or to vote in the election, you must be a former employee of the Sacramento County Employees' Retirement System according to System records. Only retired members may be candidates and/or vote for an Alternate Retired Retirement Board Representative.

CALENDAR OF EVENTS

July 21, 2025, 8 a.m.	First day to obtain candidate nomination papers.
August 1, 2025, 5 p.m.	Last day to file candidate nomination papers along with a candidate statement not exceeding 200 words.
September 15 to September 26, 2025	Voting period (by mail ballot); if using hand delivery or inter-office mail, it must be delivered to the Elections Office by 5:00 p.m. on September 26, 2025; if returning by US mail service it must be postmarked by September 26, 2025 and received by Elections Office by 5:00 p.m. October 3, 2025.
September 26, 2025, 5 p.m.	Last day to cast ballot/End of Voting Period.
October 7, 2025	Official results released.
January 1, 2026	Term of office begins.

CANDIDACY INFORMATION: Nomination papers and candidate statement forms may be obtained and filed at Voter Registration and Elections, 7000 65th Street, Suite A, Sacramento, CA 95823, Monday through Friday, from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Alternatively, they may be downloaded from www.elections.saccounty.gov and returned via email at voters-campaignservices@saccounty.gov. If a representative is delegated this responsibility, a specific letter of authorization signed by the candidate will be required.

Each candidate is allowed one 200-word statement of qualifications, which will be included in each member's voting material. This statement of qualifications is not verified or corrected by Voter Registration and Elections staff. It will be printed exactly as presented.
