Sacramento County Prepares for Logic and Accuracy Testing for November 4, 2014 General Election

Sacramento County Elections announced today that logic and accuracy testing for their voting machines will begin on September 29, 2014 and run continuously until completed.

Oct 20 – Last day to register to vote in the General Election. Voter registration forms must be mailed (postmarked by this date) or delivered to the Elections Office, 7000 65th Street, Suite A, Sacramento 95823. Online voter registration must be completed before midnight on this date.

Oct 28– Last day to request a vote-by-mail ballot be mailed to you for the General Election. Call (916) 875-6155 for information.

Nov 4 – General Election. Polls are open from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m.
