Key Election Dates

MAY 4 – First day vote by mail ballots are available. Voters will automatically receive a ballot in the mail for this election.

MAY 18 - Last day to register to vote in the Special Election. Voter registration forms must be mailed (postmarked by this date) or delivered to the Elections Office, 7000 65th Street, Suite A, Sacramento 95823. Online voter registration must be completed before midnight on this date.

JUNE 2 – Election Day. This is an all mail ballot election; no polls have been established. Election Day ballot drop-off is available at Sacramento City Hall from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. and at the Sacramento County Registrar's office from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m.
