YOUR VOTING OPTIONS



- Place your voted ballot in the return envelope
- Sign your envelope
- Must be postmarked on or before Election Day



DROP OFF YOUR BALLOT

- Drop off your voted ballot in the return envelope at any Ballot Drop Box location starting 28 days before Election Day
- A 24 hour Ballot Drop Box is located at: 7000 65th Street, Suite A Sacramento, CA 95823



VOTE AT A VOTE CENTER

- Drop off your voted ballot or vote in person at any Vote Center in Sacramento County
- Request a replacement ballot
- Vote using an accessible ballot marking device
- Receive voting assistance, including assistance in multiple languages
- Register to vote or update your registration and vote the same day

Remember to sign your ballot envelope!

If you forget to sign your envelope, you will have 8 days after Election Day to provide your signature to the Elections Office.

OVERVIEW

WHAT IS THE CA VOTER'S CHOICE ACT?

In 2016, the State of California passed Senate Bill 450, allowing select counties to conduct mail ballot elections, while also providing Vote Centers. Some Vote Centers will be open 11 days, including Election Day, and all Vote Centers will be open 4 days, including Election Day.

HOW WILL THIS AFFECT HOW I VOTE?

You will be mailed a ballot beginning 29 days before Election Day. Once you vote your ballot, you can return it:

- By mail
- At a Ballot Drop Box
- At a Vote Center

Still want to vote in person? You can vote at any Vote Center in the County. Voting sites can change, so be sure to check the list of Vote Center locations provided with your election material.

WHAT IS A VOTE CENTER?

Vote Centers replace polling places. You can vote at any Vote Center in Sacramento County. Some Vote Centers will be open 11 days, including Election Day, and all Vote Centers will be open 4 days, including Election Day.

WHY THE CHANGE?

The California Voter's Choice Act became law in 2016 to make voting more convenient and accessible. Over 64% of Sacramento County voters already vote by mail.

YOU CHOOSE

HOW TO VOTE

Through the mail, Ballot Drop Box, or Vote Center

WHEN TO VOTE

You can vote early or on Election Day at a location close to home, work, or anywhere in the County!

- Some Vote Centers will be open 11 days including Election Day
- All Vote Centers will be open 4 days including Election Day
- Election Day hours are 7:00 a.m. 8:00 p.m.

WHERE TO VOTE

You can visit any Vote Center in the County
