Call to Order:

Review of Previous Meeting's Recap and Action Items Results:

- No corrections requested to 4/24/18 Meeting notes.
- Courtney emailed out the November 2016 survey results and "no signature match" numbers to committee members.

Agenda Items, Updates and Discussion Comments:

- We are learning a lot so far and how we need to make changes for the next election, i.e., how we issue supplies and that we had issues with the laptops that were used in training not being reconfigured correctly before being sent out to the Vote Centers
- Between May 26th and May 28th, the 18 Vote Centers have received 512 Vote by Mail ballots and have issued 102 ballots.
- Vote Center observations from the committee members that went into Vote Centers: ICX printer had not been turned on yet, equipment cases stored under ICX booths, clerks encouraging people to use the ICX, not giving out voter experience cards, people want the Vote Center locations to be VBM Ballot Drop locations (need signage telling voters that the location is not a ballot drop off).
- Margaret Johnson will be an Election Clerk at Robbie Waters Pocket Greenhaven Library.
- We are using Tenex to log all calls. We will share the results at the July meeting.
- Reviewed Vote Center experience survey questions. It was recommended to have more questions regarding voter access inside the Vote Center.
