



Sacramento County Voter Registration and Elections ♦ Official Information ♦ Improvements to the upcoming June 2018 Election

Sacramento County Elections Office is offering you more opportunities for voting with the **VOTERS CHOICE ACT**.

Beginning the week of May 8, 2018 **every registered voter will be mailed a ballot**. You may return your voted ballot by mail; in any of our 52 Vote by Mail (VBM) Ballot Drop Boxes; or at a Vote Center.

Vote Centers are universal polling places that offer expanded services, and are located throughout the County.

- 78 Vote Centers are open June 2 through June 5, 2018.
- 16 of these Vote Centers open earlier beginning May 26 through June 5, 2018.
- **Any** voter can vote at **any** Vote Center in the County – you pick where you want to vote!
- Vote Centers offer in-person voting, replacement VBM ballots, accessible voting devices, registration forms, and assistance in alternate languages.

Vote Centers and Drop Box locations are on our website and will be in the Voter Information Guide mailed to you in May.
