


## THE VOTER'S CHOICE ACT

All voters will receive their ballot in the mail








Voted ballots can be returned 1 of 3 ways:

## What is a Vote Center?

A Vote Center is a universal polling place.

Any voter in the County can go to any Vote Center and:

- Cast a ballot
- Use an accessible voting machine to mark a ballot
- Request a replacement ballot
- Register/Re-Register to vote
- Cast a Conditional Ballot
- Drop off an already voted ballot







## **Conditional Voter Registration**

- Register to vote up to and including Election Day
- Cast a Conditional Voter Registration Ballot at a Vote Center

## **Welcome to Election Month!**

29 days before Election Day → Ballots are mailed to voters

28 days before Election Day → Ballot Drop Boxes open

10 days before Election Day → First Vote Centers open

3 days before Election Day → All Vote Centers open
