ARE YOU READY TO VOTE?

Registration Qualifications:

- ✓ A US citizen
- A resident of California
- √ 18 years of age on or before Election Day
- ✓ Not in prison for a conviction of a felony
- ✓ Not prohibited from voting by a court because of mental incompetency

Reminder:



All registered voters will automatically recieve their Official Ballot in the mail before each election.



Last Day to Request a Replacement Ballot: 7 days before Election Day



If you are 16-17 years of age,

you can pre-register!

Registration Closes: 15 days before Election Day



Conditional Voter Registration extends the 15-day registration deadline to eligible voters.


