Sacramento County voters can now experience their voting material in an accessible format using this new program. The Accessible Sample Ballot Pamphlet is available on the Election's homepage at www.elections.saccounty.net.

The accessible pamphlet also interfaces with voters' own assistive technology, offering voters with vision disabilities a new level of access to their voting material.

Key Election Dates

October 20 – Last day to register to vote in the November 4 General Election. Voter registration forms must be mailed (postmarked by this date) or delivered to the Elections Office, 7000 65th Street, Suite A, Sacramento 95823.

October 28 – Last day to request a vote by mail ballot be mailed to you for the November 4 election. Call (916) 875-6155 for information.

November 4 – General Election. Polls are open from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m.
