General Election Update

November 4 Final Day To Drop Off Vote By Mail Ballot

Registrar of Voters Jill LaVine reminded voters that tomorrow, November 4, will be the last day to drop off vote by mail ballots. It is too late to put your ballot in the mail. All ballots must be in our office or dropped off at a Sacramento County Polling Place in order to be counted for this election; postmarks do not count.

On Election Day, for the first time, Cal Expo will be open for voters to drive through and drop off their ballots. Voters will not even need to get out of their cars. "This is one more way our office is making it more convenient for voters to get their ballots in timely."

All polling places and drop off sites are open from 7:00 am to 8:00 pm.

Voters can call our office 916-875-6451, go <u>online</u>, or use the SacVote mobile app to find the nearest polling place to drop off their vote by mail ballot.
