Key Election Dates

APR 27 – Last day to register to vote in the Special Election. Voter registration forms must be mailed (postmarked by this date) or delivered to the Elections Office, 7000 65th Street, Suite A, Sacramento 95823. Online voter registration must be completed before midnight on this date.

MAY 5 – Last day to request a Vote By Mail ballot be mailed to you for the Special Election. Call (916) 875-6155 for information.

MAY 12 – Special Election. Polls are open from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m.
