Vote By Mail ballots in the mail

Registrar of Voters, Jill LaVine announced that beginning Monday, April 13, voters in the Twin Rivers Unified School District, Area 5, can cast their ballot through the mail or in person at the Elections Office, 7000 65th Street, Suite A, Sacramento, California. Permanent Vote By Mail voters will receive their ballot in the mail in the next few days.

It's not too late to request a vote by mail ballot for the Special Election. Registered voters have until May 5, 2015 to request a Vote By Mail ballot be mailed to them. You can request a Vote By Mail ballot by using the application printed on the back of the sample ballot booklet, applying online at www.elections.saccounty.net, or calling the Elections Office at (916) 875-6155.

Key Election Dates

APRIL 27 – Last day to register to vote in the Special Election. Voter registration forms must be mailed (postmarked by this date) or delivered to the Elections Office, 7000 65th Street, Suite A, Sacramento 95823. Online voter registration must be completed before midnight on this date.

MAY 5– Last day to request a Vote By Mail ballot be mailed to you for the Special Election. Call (916) 875-6155 for information.

MAY 12 – Special Election. Polls are open from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m.
